Attention Parents of Sixth Grade Students:

The Ohio Department of Health has just released the new immunization requirements for the 2016-2017 school year. These changes will affect your students as they enter seventh grade next fall. The ODH is now requiring that all students entering seventh grade will need to have a diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis (Tdap) booster and the Meningococcal vaccine. These immunizations can be obtained from the Allen County Health Department or from your family physician. The Allen County Health Department now requires that an appointment be scheduled in order to obtain immunizations there. You can contact the Health Department at 419-228-4457.

Your child will need to receive these immunizations before the start of school next fall. A reminder will go out in the spring and again in the summer reminding you that your student will need **both of these immunizations prior to starting 7**th **grade**. The school will require proof of these immunizations or your child could be excluded from attending school until the immunization requirement is met. Be a Summer Volunteer at St. Rita's Medical Center

Applications for the Volunteen Program at St. Rita's Medical Center are available in the literature tray in the guidance office. - Two sharpened pencils with good erasers
- An approved calculator
